

# Timber Development and Engineering Supervisor

#### **Role Overview:**

AV Terrace Bay Inc. is currently recruiting for a *Timber Development & Engineering Supervisor*, to join its fibre supply division consisting of 1.5 million cubic metres of Crown fibre supply derived from 4 forest management units located in north central Ontario as well as a significant fibre purchase program. Reporting to the Forest Resource Manager the Timber Development & Engineering Supervisor will ensure the economic and sustainable development of forest access and infrastructure across the AVTB supply area, as well as verify and maintain forest inventories. This position supports both the short and long term implementation of operational harvest and road construction programs across the same supply area.

### **Principle Responsibilities and Supporting Actions:**

- Plan and develop forest access roads, water crossings and other forest infrastructure.
  - Develop strategic and operational plans.
  - Liaise with government and stakeholders towards the issuance of all required permits and approvals.
- Verify and maintain standing forest inventories for the development and implementation of annual operational harvest plans.
  - Maintain accurate inventories and recommend short/long-term woodflows.
- Coordinate road maintenance activities on key haul routes
  - Direct contract road maintenance equipment in support of a safe and efficient haul.
- Support the long and short-term planning of operational harvest and road construction programs across multiple forests.
  - Support forest management plan development.
  - o Coordinate the application and approval of all annual operating permits.
  - Maintain Company aggregate interests.
- Lead the development of forest access and infrastructure budgets.
  - Develop both road construction and maintenance budgets to support annual operating plans.



- Act as a representative of the Company in meetings with other organizations to serve the interests of the Company.
  - Represent the Company on operations committees, local citizens committees, interest groups, etc.
  - Represent oneself in all Company business in an honest, professional and respectable manner at all times.
- Manage spatial datasets and produce map products.
- Ensure compliance and adherence to all statutory forest management and environmental requirements.
  - o Report on compliance to all standards as required.
- Participate on the fibre supply team by recommending opportunities for improvement at the unit level and contributing to the development of group strategies.
- Performing all job duties in a safe and environmentally responsible manner.
- Other duties as required.
