

ArborMetrics Solutions is seeking motivated, highly skilled individuals to fill contract supervision and vegetation planning roles. Key tasks will include planning, scheduling, auditing, and reporting for electric utility vegetation management, and integrated pole maintenance programs.

ArborMetrics Solutions is currently seeking an individuals to fill multiple positions throughout the southern portion of *Manitoba*. Preferences will be given to local applicants or applicants that are able to reside in the province of Manitoba. Employment packages include a minimum of a 40-hour workweek, company vehicle, and ample opportunities for overtime and growth in the industry. Work is scheduled around home bases however travel will be required. These positions are temporary full time positions for 6 months of employment (ending in November/December 2017). Employment opportunities with ArborMetrics Solutions after 6 months is possible but not guaranteed. Interviews are scheduled for the week of May 1 to 5, 2017 with the positions starting May 15 or May 23, 2017.

The following is required for all our job openings; Supervisory experience, valid First Aid and CPR, proficient in the operation and use of computers including Microsoft Office (Outlook, Word, and Excel). Must be willing to travel. All successful applicants must have a valid driver's license.

Utility Vegetation Mechanical Clearing Supervision:

This field position will focus on the supervision/inspection of crews physically removing vegetation around powerlines. Required experience includes Grade 12 with a minimum of two years of experience working in the utility industry. Preference will be given to applicants with; UTT/UTW certification, 2 or 4-year diploma/ degree in forestry, horticulture, natural resources, or related field. ISA Certified Tree Worker, Certified Arborist, or Utility Specialist designation would be an asset. Experience related to herbicide application, mulching, tree falling, and tree trimming (climbing and/or from a bucket) is also considered an asset.

Utility Integrated Pole Maintenance Supervision:

This field position will focus on the supervision of crews inspecting, treating, and physically maintaining power pole structures. Required experience includes Grade 12 with a minimum of two years of experience working in the utility industry. Preference will be given to applicants with; Experience with integrated pole maintenance practices, Journeyman Lineman, Powerline Technician, 2 or 4-year diploma/ degree in forestry, horticulture, natural resources, or related field, Project Management, and/or or credentials in a related discipline.

Utility Vegetation Planner:

This field position will focus on assessing vegetation around powerlines and creating vegetation maintenance plans on Distribution or Transmission rights of way. Preference will be given to those with electric utility or line clearance experience; 2 or 4-year diploma/ degree in forestry, horticulture, natural resources, or related field. ISA Certified Tree Worker, Certified Arborist, or Utility Specialist designation would be an asset. Experience related to herbicide application, mulching, tree falling, and tree trimming (climbing and/or from a bucket) is also considered an asset. Strong computer skills with a wide range of applications from Microsoft Excel to GPS technology will be used in this position.
