

Ministry of Forests Lands and Natural Resource Operations – BC Timber Sales

Practices Forester Salary \$55,601.52 -\$69,445.80 annually plus \$38.87 Bi-weekly Isolation Allowance

<u>BC Timber Sales</u> is a semi-autonomous program within the Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations with financial and operational independence.

As a Practices Forester, you perform a wide variety of professional and technical services to support the development and operational stages of pre and post Timber Sale License awards and active harvest operations within your field team. Working with a team of Forest Professionals including BCTS staff and external contractors, your responsibilities in Mackenzie may focus on: forest development, including layout and development, site plan review and amendment, timber appraisal submissions, operational and access planning, assessments, monitoring and evaluation of harvest operations or engineering activities.

This position may also include: silviculture activities including contract monitoring and administration for planting, brushing, site preparation, and survey program; completing sowing requests for our planting program; legal reporting such as free growing declarations and Site Plan amendments; First Nations and stakeholder consultation; and other associated silviculture duties.

Qualifications for this role include:

- A Registered Professional Forester (RPF), or be eligible for registration as an RPF with the Association of BC Forest Professionals (ABCFP) and two years (gained within the last five years) of experience in operational forestry such as forest tenures, cut-block and road development, engineering, silviculture, harvest operations or compliance and enforcement.
- Preference may be given to applicants with specific forestry experience in one or more operational field-based forestry activities such as forest tenures, cut-block and road development, engineering, silviculture, harvest operations, compliance and enforcement, integrated resource management or forestry contract administration.
