This **Visual Resource Management Specialist** within the Ministry of Forests, Lands, & Natural Resource Operations is a unique position in the West Coast Region. The position provides specialized expertise and leadership in the field of visual resource management of Crown land, including implementation of legislation, policies and procedures for the protection and enhancement of visual and scenic values for public recreational enjoyment and the tourism sector. The position promotes a balanced approach to forest management and other industrial activities on BC's visually sensitive landscape.

This position will monitor the implementation of the VRM program and provides expert advice to internal and external stakeholders on all aspects of the visual resource management (VRM) process across the Coast Area. This position requires someone who is a highly effective communicator with leadership skills and is able to build productive working relationships with staff and the natural resource sector industries and practitioners.

This is a rewarding opportunity to use your experience in forest management, engage in exciting work and advance your forestry career.

Qualifications for this role include:

- Registered or immediately eligible for registration either as a Registered Professional Forester (R.P.F.) with the Association of BC Forest Professionals (preferred) or as a Professional Agrologist (P.Ag.) with the BC Institute of Agrologists, or as a Professional Engineer (P.Eng). with the Association of BC Professional Engineers and Geoscientists. *Immediately eligible means you are a registered professional and a current member in good standing with the association of your specialty area in another Canadian jurisdiction and can be transferred to BC*
- Master's degree in forestry or related resource management field with an emphasis on visual resource management and a minimum three (3) years of forestry related experience, or a Bachelor's degree in forestry or related resource management field and a minimum five (5) years of forestry related experience or an equivalent combination of education, training and experience.
- Demonstrated experience in visual resource management concepts, principles and practices.
- Valid BC Drivers Licence.
