The Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development is responsible for stewardship of Provincial Crown land and natural resources, and protection of B.C.'s archaeological and heritage resources.

The role of the Manager, Forest Inventory is to lead a team of professional, scientific, technical staff in the development, collection and delivery of a coordinated program for the estimation, projection and monitoring of the provincial forest resources. This position ensures that there are comprehensive, consistent and reliable statistical and analytical techniques, standards, quality assurance procedures, information and decision support tools for all inventory information and provides advice, information and reports regarding the provincial forest resource inventory for strategic and operational planning.

Qualifications for this role include:

- Diploma or Bachelor of Science in resource management, forestry, or related studies and at least 7 years of forest management experience; OR, an equivalent combination of experience and education.
- A minimum of five years of experience in the use, collection and management of forest management and inventory data (includes monitoring and Growth and Yield Data) and a solid understanding of statistical and analytic tools, data storage and retrieval systems and the management of large data sets.
- Demonstrated experience developing legislation and/or regulations, strategic planning, budgeting and contract administration and project management.
- Registration or eligibility for registration with the Association of BC Forest Professionals (Registered Professional Forester) preferred.
- Knowledge of the Forest Estate Modelling information needs and the Timber Supply Review Program in BC, major forest policy issues in BC, relevant acts, regulations and policies, and the ministry, its mandate, structure, key partners and priorities preferred.
