BC Timber Sales (BCTS) was founded in 2003 with a mandate to provide the cost and price benchmarks for timber harvested from public land in British Columbia. BCTS plans, develops, and auctions as much as 20% of the province's annual available volume. The bid prices received from auctioned timber and costs of developing the timber are available to support market pricing of the province's timber.

The Engineering Technician is responsible for coordinating, implementing and monitoring engineering activities for a specific field area in a TSO. The position provides engineering expertise and advice to operational staff and works closely with the Engineering Specialist and Woodlands Supervisor to ensure environmental, construction and legislative requirements are met. The position is required to administer parts of the engineering program including contractual engineering services for the Timber Supply Office.

Qualifications for this role include:

- Diploma in forest engineering, forest management, engineering or equivalent related field, plus two years of recent work experience in a directly related field within the last five years.  
**OR**  
An equivalent combination of education and experience such as three years of experience, attained within the last five years, in two or more in the following areas: road and block layout, forestry contract administration, forest engineering and engineering.
- Applicants must be registered or eligible for registration with the Association of British Columbia Forest Professionals as a Registered Forest Technologist.
