Key Responsibilities: Operations Supervisors work under the direction and supervision of the Operations Manager and Operations Forester and are responsible for monitoring logging and road construction operations. Focus must be maintained on: conformance to contractual obligations; maintenance of safe working conditions, log quality control; tracking realized production against production targets and adjusting operations accordingly and maintaining company goals.

FORESTRY OPERATIONS

- Administer plans and contracts pertaining to logging, road building, bridge installation and deactivation.
- Supervise and administer plans and contracts pertaining to logging, road building, bridge installation and deactivation.
- Complete pre-harvest walkthroughs.
- Assemble documentation for and complete pre-work meetings.
- Liaise with Work Safe BC, Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations, Ministry of Transportation and Department of Fisheries and Oceans representatives.
- Implement safe work practices and procedures internally and amongst contractors.
- Review contractor safety programs.
- Complete harvest inspections and monitor log quality.
- Conduct road and bridge inspections.
- Ensure all operational post-harvest obligations are completed.

Education:

- ABCFP Registered Professional Forester or Registered Forest Technologist designation is preferred but not required.
- Undergraduate degree or technical diploma in Forestry or natural resources field is preferred but not required.

Experience:

- Three years or more of experience in forestry or industrial logging.

Personal Attributes:

- Must be decisive, assertive and able to enforce contractual obligations.
- Must be organized and able to maintain concise and explicit inspection reports.
- Must be willing to travel extensively on resource road networks, between multiple operating areas and able to maintain a mobile workspace.
- Must be familiar with BC Forestry Legislation, Regulations and Policy & Practices.
- Ability to work with little or no supervision.
