Position Title: Planning Forester

Location: Terrace, British Columbia

Key Responsibilities: Planning Foresters work under the direction and supervision of the Forestry Manager and are responsible for completing timber development. Focus must be maintained on compliance with legislation, stewardship obligations, adherence to budgets and company goals.

TIMBER DEVELOPMENT

- Conduct or lead timber identification.
- Complete or lead timber reconnaissance.
- Maintain the information sharing process with First Nations and stakeholders.
- Maintain proforma models throughout timber development process.
- Entry of development information into Phoenix data system.
- Supervise and administer development contracts.
- Mentor Forest Technicians.
- Direct development consultants and Forest Technicians through block and road layout.
- Complete, co-ordinate and peer review all required assessments.
- Complete and peer review block and road Site Plans.
- Lead stumpage estimation.
- Complete cutting/road permit acquisition.

Education:

- ABCFP Registered Professional Forester or Registered Forest Technologist designation is required.
- Undergraduate degree or technical diploma in Forestry or natural resources field is preferred.

Experience:

- Three years or more of experience in Forestry.

Personal Attributes:

- Must be meticulously organized and highly attentive to detail.
- Must be creative, willing and able to find solutions to timber development challenges that result in permit acquisition.
- Must be familiar with First Nations information-sharing and consultation requirements, outgoing and willing to extend all reasonable effort to maintain communication with First Nations affected by BFL's timber development and operations.
- Must be diplomatic, focussed and able to effectively communicate with representatives from the Province of British Columbia.
- Must be familiar with BC Forestry Legislation, Regulations and Policy & Practices.
- Ability to work independently.
