REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

Canadian Forest Products Ltd. is a leading integrated forest products company based in Vancouver, British Columbia. Canfor operates sawmills throughout the interior of BC and Alberta. Canfor also owns a 50.2% interest in Canfor Pulp Limited Partnership (CPLP).

Canfor is interested in soliciting individual proposals for the following project within the Mackenzie Operations Division:

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

The project to be completed is for the deactivation and installation of an 18m bridge on the Thutade (Manson) FSR. The project location is approximately a 2hr drive north of Mackenzie in the vicinity of the town of Manson Creek. Work Crew accommodations for the project will be provided at Canfor's Munro Camp. The scope of the project includes removal of the existing structure, removal of temporary bridge and installation of new bridge on lock block foundation. Materials, engineering and environmental monitoring will be provided by the MFLNRO. Removal and installation of the temporary bridge to the new location must be completed on a weekend so as not to impact log hauling operations.

Prior to obtaining an RFP package, contractors must provide a prospectus with the following information:

- i. A brief description of your company, including; services offered, history, number of employees, major assets and the like.
- ii. Company contact name and phone number.
- iii. At least two (2) references for whom you have completed similar work. Include name of project reference, location, size and term (length) of contract, contact's name and phone number.

TIMELINES:

It is anticipated that RFP Packages to include Final Road and Structure Designs will be available to interested contractors by October 6th.

RFP Submissions will be due October 18th.

All work associated with this project will need to be completed by **November 15th**.
