Moore Creek Culvert: 50+500 Km Michelle Bay FSR:

Install a new 2000mm X 31.0m long CSP Culvert as per Design Drawing Name: **340-10-01 to 05 Rev. 0.**

Site #3 Unnamed Creek Culvert: 80+100 Km Michelle Bay FSR:

Install a new 3100mm Span X 1980mm Rise X 42.0m long Pipe Arch Culvert as per Design Drawing Name: **361-21-01 to 05 Rev. 0.**

The Michelle Bay FSR, locally known as the North Road, starts just west of Houston, BC and travels North East to Babine Lake near Topley Landing. The FSR can be accessed at various points from Hwy 16 and the Granisle Highway located 29.5Km east of Houston B.C. The Michelle Bay FSR can be accessed by two wheel drive to the proposed installation sites from any of these access points.
