Qualifications

An in-depth knowledge of the forest industry and silviculture systems is essential. They will have demonstrated experience in successfully managing staff and budgets, with excellent organizational, communications, facilitation and mediation skills. Must be able to demonstrate well developed team approach to problem solving, fair and consistent leadership skills in strategic planning, implementing change, and be results oriented with a high level of initiative and motivation.
