Reporting to the Manager of the Landscape Protection Unit, Parks Division and located in Regina, a primary role of the Senior Park Landscape Ecologist will be to provide scientific-based direction and advice to Landscape Protection Unit staff, executive management and park managers on landscape health and ecological protection for the provincial park system.

In addition, other duties include, but are not limited to the development and implementation of ecosystem-based management plans, management of climate change adaptation and providing for species at risk management on provincial park lands. This position will work closely and provide direction to other Landscape Protection Unit ecologists, various academia, non government agencies (NGO's) and other interest groups in developing and implementing scientific-based management plans and practices to address or restore ecosystem health on provincial park forests, grasslands and associated watersheds. The incumbent will also play a lead role in the development and implementation of a carrying capacity model, specifically from an ecological perspective which will assist park managers in determining impacts of developments and over utilization of sensitive lands within the provincial park system. This position is also responsible to lead the development, approvals and implementation of science-based research projects and studies conducted on the provincial park lands.
