



FOREST INVENTORY TECHNICIANS

Sumac is seeking highly motivated and result oriented personnel to join our forest inventory team for the 2017 field season. Current projects are located in Northwestern and Northeastern Ontario and include enhanced Forest Resource Inventory (eFRI) Ground Calibration Plots, Permanent Sample Plots and Regeneration Condition Surveys.

Preference will be given to applicants with previous Ontario eFRI experience.

Work will include:

- Plot location with 4 wheel drive truck, ATV, boat, helicopter or float plane
- Forest mensuration (basal area, tree diameter, height, age)
- Identification of tree species and lesser vegetation
- Description and classification of forest soils
- Ecological Land Classification (ELC/FEC)

Qualifications:

- Previous Ontario eFRI experience;
- Degree or Diploma in Forestry or related discipline;
- Experience in related or similar work and proficiency with required field equipment (GPS, Prisms, Vertex, Increment borers etc.);
- Excellent navigation and map reading skills with experience in remote access situations;
- Physically fit and able to perform duties in a variety of weather and terrain conditions;
- Be safety conscious and have good organizational and time management skills;
- Have the ability to change and adapt with rigors of field work and, a willingness to learn new skills;
- Valid Ontario "G" Driver's License or equivalent with a clean driving record;
- Valid First Aid Certificate; and
- Pleasure Craft Operators Certificate.
