THE ROLE

The successful candidate will play a direct role in maximizing value from standing timber through to the final sale of logs.

Responsibilities include actively managing the valuation of timber and the processing of logs from the falling phase through the dryland sorting and booming phases to ensure the highest use and maximum value is achieved for all logs. This includes accurate tracking of volumes leaving camp by boom and/or barge. The successful candidate will work closely with engineering staff to develop standing timber harvest valuations and produce timber proformas and budgets for timber being assessed.

For candidates applying as a **Log Trader**, responsibilities also include marketing and selling logs to domestic and export customers, developing and maintaining customer relationships, identifying market opportunities, and maximizing value through effective log marketing strategies. The level of trading responsibility will be determined by the experience and capabilities of the successful candidate.

This is a hands-on, field-focused position with exposure to a wide variety of timber types and operating conditions across the BC Coast. Travel by truck, boat, helicopter, and fixed-wing aircraft is a normal part of the role.

The position is primarily a 5/2 work week with occasional shift work as required and reports directly to the General Manager of Log Supply.
