#### Qualifications for this role include:

- Graduation with a diploma or degree in resource or forestry management.
- Registered with the Association of British Columbia Forest Professionals (ABC FP) as a Registered Forest Technologist (RFT) or a Registered Professional Forester (RPF) AND a minimum of two years of experience in operational field forestry activities; **OR**
- Enrolled, or eligible for immediate enrollment, with the Association of British Columbia Forest Professionals (ABC FP) as a forest professional in training (TFT, ASTFT, FIT, ASFIT), for the purpose of obtaining an RFT or RPF designation AND a minimum of four years of experience in operational field forestry activities.

#### Operational field forestry activities include one or more of the following:

- Timber harvesting cut-block development.
- Forest road engineering.
- Silviculture.
- Harvest operations.
- Compliance and enforcement.
- Must possess t minimum a valid Class 5 B.C. Driver's License that does not limit or restrict the ability to conduct the duties of the job.
