## The role of Forestry Assistant is to:

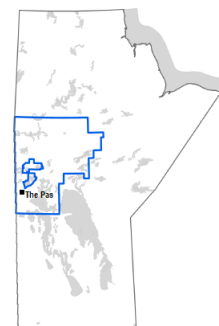
- Take part in two main field projects:
