Position: Full time, Seasonal and Summer Forestry Field Positions

Locations: Prince George, Burns Lake, and Chetwynd.

DWB Consulting Services Ltd. (DWB) is a dynamic consulting firm specializing in offering our clients forestry, engineering, and environmental services. DWB employs diversified professional and technical staff with a wide range of experience. We employ Forest Professionals, Professional Biologists, Professional Engineers, Professional Agrologists, and many technical staff. Our team approach and quality service has resulted in many long-term, direct award relationships with clients in the forest, mining, oil and gas, and transportation sectors.

DWB is seeking applications for **Forestry Field Positions** in our northern divisions. We have full time, seasonal (6-8 months) and summer (4 month) opportunities available beginning in May 2021. You must be willing to work long hours in remote locations often under adverse weather conditions. Camp work is likely in all divisions. The positions are physically and mentally demanding. Preference will be given to candidates enrolled in accredited Forestry diploma or degree programs.

DWB's main area of forestry and engineering work is in pre-harvest timber development. Annually we develop approximately 2 to 3 million cubic meters of timber (full phase development) as well as the layout, survey, and design of many kilometers of main haul road systems and crossing structures. Assigned duties will be based on the candidate's experience and may include block and road layout, deflection lines, timber cruising, riparian assessments, site plan data collection, silviculture surveys and GPS traversing.

Company Divisions:

Prince George (PG) is the main office for our four northern Divisions. We often supply crews to Burns Lake, Chetwynd, or Fort St John depending upon workloads. DWB has no company accommodations in PG however rental opportunities within the city are more readily available than in other locations. Most work from PG is camp based. Five-day shifts are the most common, however ten day shifts may be required.

Chetwynd: Company accommodations are available at our Chetwynd house for full time and summer students. Depending upon the term, either a taxable benefit or rent would apply. Accommodations include WIFI, satellite TV, full kitchen, laundry, cleaning service, and utilities. The house is located within walking distance of all amenities so a vehicle is not required. Most of our Chetwynd work is local therefore crews usually return each night to Chetwynd.

Burns Lake: Similar to Chetwynd, company accommodations are also available. However, the office/accommodations are 10 minutes south of Burns Lake so a vehicle is recommended for transportation. Much of the work is camp based with 5-day shifts being the standard shift length.

DWB offers a competitive salary, and for those being offered full-time employment, we offer a health benefits package. DWB recognizes the importance of work-life balance and as a result, we strive to accommodate the time off requirements of all our staff. Where applicable, DWB offers a moving allowance to assist with travel expenses for summer or full-time work (claimed only after 3 months of employment). DWB also offers a year-end employee bonus subject to company policy (available to students and full-time staff).
