The Forestry Manager will be responsible for overseeing a tenure assembly of two Forest Licenses and one TFL with a combined annual volume of 125,000 m³ annually. Tenures operate in the Sunshine Coast TSA and operations are remote, primarily in the area of Bute Inlet. This position requires a value driven, hands-on individual with strong leadership skills, a deep understanding of forestry operations, and the ability to effectively manage multiple contractors and projects.
