- Data collection and entry of relevant information relating to engineering and recce projects

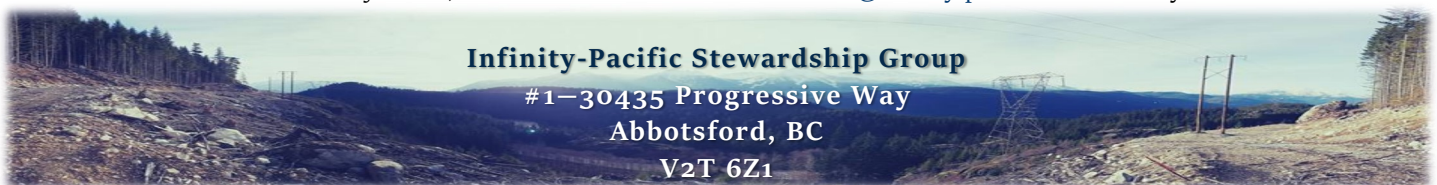
Qualifications and Requirements
