### Silviculture Forester

The Community Forest license grants McBride Community Forest Corporation exclusive rights to harvest Crown timber from approximately 60,000 ha surrounding the community of McBride.

The Village of McBride is a rural community with a population of approximately 600, nestled between the Rocky Mountains and the North Cariboo Mountains, within the historical Robson Valley. It is strategically located on Highway 16, just short trips away from Prince George, Jasper and Kamloops.

The Community Forest is intended to give the community management control over the forest directly surrounding the community in order to manage it for all values of importance to the community - environment, water, recreation, visuals, wildlife, etc. It also offers an opportunity to stimulate economic activity and provide a monetary return back to the community.

MCFC is seeking a Silviculture Forester to join our team. This full-time union, permanent position works hands-on under minimal supervision, with considerable independent judgment and action required in matters which are within the framework of established procedures.

#### **Key Job Duties and Responsibilities:**

Your primary responsibilities will be focused on, but certainly not limited to the following:

- Gathering site prescription data.
- Preparing site prescriptions for reforestation, stand tending, and site preparation.
- Supervision of consultants and activities.
- Ensure forestry records and RESULTS data entries are well organized.
- Assist in the preparation of annual silviculture planning and budgeting.

#### **The ideal candidate would have the following:**

- Be a graduate from a recognized forestry school and be an RPF, RFT, or be eligible to enroll as a Forester-In-Training or Trainee Forest Technologist with the Association of BC Forest Professionals.
- Have experience in Silviculture, or timber development in the B.C. Interior.
- Have a working knowledge of all related legislation and regulations.
- Excellent oral, written and electronic communication skills.
