The McLeod Lake Mackenzie Community Forest (MLMCF) is based in Mackenzie BC and oversees the management and stewardship of 26,322 hectares in the Mackenzie TSA under the K2M Community Forest Agreement with an annual allowable cut of 38,500m³.

The MLMCF is a well-established community forest organization looking to continue and expand on our mandate to deliver sound, progressive forest stewardship as well as a diversity of benefits to its shareholder communities of Mackenzie and the McLeod Lake Indian Band.

Among other initiatives, the MLMCF has a seasoned and growing Project Funding Program and continues to lead wildfire fuel management treatments in the Mackenzie area. At this time the community forest is in need of a second forester to assist with the management of the K2M tenure and delivery of community forest programs.

Working directly with the General Manager the successful applicant's responsibilities will be varied but focused heavily on coordination and oversight of operational activities from timber development and silviculture to road construction and harvesting. Wildfire fuel management planning and implementation will also be a significant component of their role.

Work will involve a mix of office and field time. The K2M tenure is made up of six units all within reasonable proximity to Mackenzie so field work does not require camp stay.

Applicants must:

- have a degree or diploma in forestry or a related field;
- must be registered with the Association of BC Forest Professionals (ABCFP) or working towards registration (RPF, FIT or RFT);
- have a minimum five years of sound forestry experience;
- have a valid Class 5 driver's license;
- be organized, capable, innovative and confident to work safely and independently in a variety of work settings including the field;
- be proficient with various Microsoft Office applications (required for preparing letters, reports, data capturing, manipulation and presentation, database entry etc.); and

-be enthusiastic and passionate about forest stewardship.

-active outdoor enthusiast
