The Role

Reporting to the Senior Manager, Logistics, the Fleet Supervisor leads the development, roll-out and ongoing implementation of the Fleet Management program which focuses on the safe and efficient operations for a fleet of approx. 300 log haulers.

Specific responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- > Enhancing safety protocols and communication processes for Log Haulers;
- > Providing functional guidance, work direction, coaching, and performance management on log hauling practices to all employees and contractors;
- > Developing and implementing strategic initiatives for fleet management;
- > Identifying areas of risk and developing mitigation and prevention strategies;
- > Developing, maintaining and distributing hauling metrics to various parties;
- > Managing the Mosaic Training Program for Log Haulers;
- > Creating the Log Haul Standard Operating Procedures video series for industrial training success;
- > Participating in and contributing to the hauling deployment plan;
- > Creating hauling allocations by geographic areas;

- > Demonstrated leadership in safety and environmental stewardship;
- > Excellent communication skills including facilitation skills;
- > Ability to manage large projects;
- > Knowledge of coastal timber, transportation regulations and coastal harvesting operations;
- > Work experience in a unionized environment will be considered an asset; and
- > Accreditation with the ABCFP as a Registered Professional Forester, or a Registered Forest Technologist (or eligible for accreditation) will be considered an asset.
