### The Role

Reporting to the VP, Operations, the Manager, Infrastructure oversees and manages the Company's physical asset/logging operations infrastructure, providing leadership within operations with a strong focus on maintaining a high standard in asset management relative to safety, environment, quality, productivity, and cost. Specific responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- > Ensures logging operations infrastructure (roads, bridges, culverts, major crossings, etc.) are well maintained and in good condition.
- > Ensures infrastructure planning is optimized with effective implementation to meet standards that satisfy customer needs.
- > Oversees inspection and monitoring physical asset conditions.
- > Supports operations with roads, bridges, and culvert installations including planning, maintenance, and annual budgeting activities.
- > Coordinates asset maintenance activities with the Senior Manager, Planning & Engineering, and the Manager, Hydrology & Terrain.
- > Maintains the asset management plan including defining long-term planning for logging operations assets.
- > Identifies areas of risk and mitigation strategies and supports implementation; and
- > Attends and participates in safety and senior management meetings.

### Required Skills and Experience

- > Forestry Diploma or Degree with RFT or RPF designation.
- > P.Eng. or Civil Tech. Diploma preferred but not required;
- > 7+ years experience in increasingly responsible management positions with timberlands operations;
- > Valid Class 5 Drivers Licence.
- > Leadership capacity in safety and environmental stewardship;

- > Experience in operational cut block planning and/or bridge and/or road construction;
- > Demonstrated ability to execute large capital projects;
- > Demonstrated ability to plan and organize work, and lead consultants and staff to execute a wide range of projects simultaneously; and
- > Demonstrated ability to prepare and manage budgets to meet corporate goals.
