As the Operations Supervisor you will be responsible for implementing a robust silviculture and ecological harvesting program. Working with leaders in the Nova Scotia forest sector, you will be responsible for setting new standards for how forestry is implemented on the landscape of the Wabanaki (Acadian) Forest.

North Nova is a private land forest co-operative that was established in 1976 that has grown from six original members to more than 430 current members and more than 75,000 acres of forested land under advisement. It is guided by a six-member board of directors and a manager.
