### **Job Description:**

This position is a full-time, permanent role based in Westbank, BC.

#### **Duties:**

- Implementation of our Seven Generation Plan through field engineering/ layout of cutblocks and roads:
- Assist in the preparation of the various plans and assessments associated with cutblock development including:
  - Riparian assessments, SP data collection, and timber cruising.
- Day to day Field crew supervision of junior staff.

# **Qualifications:**

- Post-secondary degree or diploma in Forestry or a relevant discipline.
- Registered or eligible for registration with FPBC as a RPF or RFT. FITs, ASFITs, TFTs and ASTFTs will be considered.
- 2 + years of development/layout experience. Candidates with other forestry experience will still be considered.
- Seeking an opportunity to work on First Nation owned, area-based forest tenures.
- Interest in working for a company that seeks to redefine good forest stewardship.
