- Work with other resource management specialists to develop solutions aligned with the Ministry's ecosystem management principles.

Typically, the competencies required for this position would be obtained through the completion of a forestry technician program, a forestry degree program or allied science degree program combined with experience with forest operations including operational planning, harvesting, road construction and reclamation, water crossing installation and reclamation, boreal forest silviculture.

Consideration will be given to candidates graduating in April 2025.

The successful candidate must possess a valid driver's license and be eligible to obtain membership in the Association of Saskatchewan Forestry Professional within three (3) years of commencement.
