Typically, the competencies required for this position would be obtained through the completion of a degree in forestry, combined with forest industry or government forestry agency experience with forest operations including operational planning, harvesting, road construction and decommissioning, water crossing installation and reclamation, and boreal forest silviculture. Consideration will be given to candidates graduating in April 2024.

The successful candidate must possess a valid driver's license and be eligible for registration in The Association of Saskatchewan Forestry Professionals within 3 years of commencement.
