DESCRIPTION

We are currently recruiting Junior/Intermediate Technical Resource Personnel to assist in our Resource/Timber Development, Vegetation Management and Wildfire Risk Reduction Projects.

Intermediate Resource Technician: This role has you working with a team of professionals responsible for all vegetation management/inspection activities and timber development duties. The successful candidate for this position should be a “self-starter” with a strong focus on safety and productivity. A minimum of 2 years experience in the natural resource sector is expected for the intermediate position. This position is field-based with the majority of works within the Thompson Nicola Region. This position is “seasonal” but may extend into the winter depending on workloads. Full-time work may be available at the completion of the work term but is not guaranteed.

Junior Resource Technician: This position is suited for those looking to gain work experience in the natural resource sector and are eager to work in a “field” setting. Candidate should be physically fit with a strong attention to detail, good attitude and willingness to learn. Experience operating ATV’s and driving resource roads is beneficial for this position. This position is seasonal and primarily field-based. A forestry/natural resource background is an asset but not required.

As a Junior/Intermediate Resource Technician you will be responsible to provide technical expertise in all aspects of our multi-disciplined projects including but not limited to:
