With demonstrated professionalism and a steadfast commitment to safety as a priority, successful candidates will be able to take initiative, work both independently and collaboratively, manage priorities, time and possess excellent communication skills.

The **Planning Forester** will have at least 5 years of forestry experience and be a Registered Professional Forester (RPF) or Registered Forest Technologist. This position will appeal to those that want the responsibility of planning operations under company tenures and managing First Nation agreements and partnerships for wood supply for our manufacturing facilities.

The **Operations Forester** will have at least 5 years of forestry experience and be a Registered Professional Forester (RPF) or Registered Forest Technologist (RFT). This position will appeal to those that want responsibility of managing operations including road and bridge building, maintenance, deactivation, harvesting, transportation, and log quality. This includes fibre sourced from company tenures, First Nation partnerships, purchases and trades.

The **Forestry Supervisor** will have less than 5 years of forestry experience and be registered as, or eligible to be a Registered Professional Forester or Registered Forest Technologists. These positions will appeal to those wanting to further expand their careers by working in multiple disciplines within the forestry field, providing personal growth and achievement.

Successful candidates will be given opportunities to expand their experience in addition to roles commensurate with their qualifications. These positions are flexible, providing opportunity for involvement in many aspects of the business.
