To be considered for the **Forestry Supervisor** role, you possess at least three (3) years of forestry experience and are a Registered Professional Forester (RPF) or Registered Forest Technologist (RFT). This position will appeal to those that want responsibility of managing operations including road and bridge building, maintenance, deactivation, harvesting, transportation, and log quality. This includes fibre sourced from company tenures, First Nation partnerships, purchases and trades.
