General Job Description:

Forestry Technician - We are currently looking to fill **2-3 field positions** the fall of 2022, with the possibility of extending into a permanent role. Duties will consist of forest inventory work such as PSPs, TSPs, research projects along with various silviculture surveys. As this is a field position, candidates must be physically fit, willing to work outdoors in all weather conditions within reason. Forestry workers perform a variety of duties related to reforestation and improvement and conservation of forest lands. Tall timber Resources Inc. is contracted by forestry companies, contractors, and government services.

Preference will be given to applicants with 1 or more years of experience or equivalent background, but training may be provided to the right candidate with less experience.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Collect inventory measurements of trees (DBH, Height, Codes, Species etc)
- Become familiar with forestry programs such as TSPs, PSPs, RLPs, Silviculture surveys, layout and complete data collection for those programs.



- Maintain communication with fellow crew members, crew leaders, and supervisor/management.
- Meet and follow the standards set by supervisors/management.
- Driving, walking, ATV, and snowmobile operation are required to access the worksite.
- Maintain and inspect the equipment, work tools and PPE in the right conditions.
- Attend training sessions and safety meetings as required.
- Follow the health and safety program of the company.

Qualifications required for the Job:

- The worker has completed or is in a degree or diploma program in Forestry or related Natural Sciences. Or has 1+ years of field related experience.
- Willing to work long shifts 12-5 rotation (Roughly and may vary from shift to shift)
- Willing to camp in remote locations if needed (All camping gear supplied)
- GIS/GPS experience; using Arc view, DNR Garmin, Garmins and Trimbles
- Strong field skills including ATV, snowmobile and working in remote areas in all seasons
- Willing and able to work outdoors in all weather conditions for extended periods.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Valid Driver's License and clean abstract
- Valid First Aid certificate
- Valid safety tickets (WHMIS, TDG, ATV, fire safety training etc.)
