THE POSITION

The Forest Technician is mainly responsible for cutblock development activities, including the assessment/marketing road centerline and cutblock boundaries, various natural resource assessments, and report writing. Some forest measurements, or other typical forest services may be required as well. These deliveries are expected to be conducted in a safe, efficient, cost effective and professional manner.

This is a production paid position, with the Forest Technician being paid by the completed, laid out distance in meters. Applicant pay will be based on experience and productivity. The typical shift is 10 days on and 4 days off, with a minimum of 10 hours spent in the field daily. The first project for this position will be helicopter access, flying out of Swan Hills and/or High Prairie for much of 2025.

Crew lodging is provided either in High Prairie or Swan Hills. Out of town work may be required. If so, all applicable costs will be covered and managed by Top Height: including accommodations, vehicle and equipment costs.

- Valid class 5 driver's license,
- Physically fit,
- Able to work outdoors in all weather conditions,
