Reporting to the General Manager, the Maintenance Manager is responsible for the safe and efficient maintenance of the mill. The Maintenance Manager utilizes related experience, project management expertise, leadership abilities and a preventative maintenance mindset in a cost-effective manner.

Duties and responsibilities include but are not limited to the management of a highly qualified maintenance team, maintaining maximum uptime and open communications with production. Active participation in the operation's efforts towards providing a safe working environment along with continuous innovation and process improvements initiatives.

Key Responsibilities Include:

- Implements, designs, utilizes and enforces proactive safety steps. Participates in regular safety meetings with the mindset all accidents are preventable;
- Oversees short and long term project plans for all maintenance activities including shutdowns;
- Sources and liaises with outside contractors;
- Tracks mill downtime issues and builds a corrective action plan to prevent reoccurrence and or reduce downtime and ensure the mill's uptime is at or above target;
- Participates in planning and recommendation of capital projects as part of the management team;
- Provides input for the creation of the yearly maintenance budget;
- Submits month-end and quarterly reports regarding major down time events, highlights, and capital project updates;
- Oversees labour requirements for maintenance team providing guidance, direction, mentoring and accountability.

Qualifications:

- The ideal candidate will have a minimum of five (5) years of industrial maintenance management experience;
- Engineering or Journeyman qualification (Electrical, Millwright, or HD Technician) or equivalent.
- Proficient and knowledgeable regarding preventative maintenance tools such as: lubrication, vibration analysis and thermography as well as extensive hydraulic and project management experience;
- Strong organizational, interpersonal and communication skills are required;
- A commitment to safe work practices;
- Experience with a computerized maintenance system is essential.
