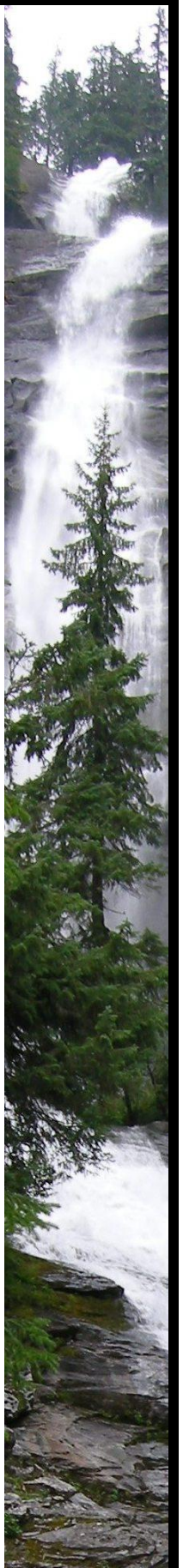

THE JOB

This will be largely a field-based position but will also include office time. The Crew Supervisor / Project Lead will:

- **Prepare** road designs, planning maps, cruise plans / compilations, LiDAR analysis, and cutting permits.

- **Provide Team Support** and gain experience in other natural resource sectors.

QUALIFICATIONS

Your experience includes:

- **Ability** to work with planners to layout cutblocks and roads in mountainous terrain (ideally with 3+ years of experience).
- **Experienced** with GPS and road surveying (level 2), and competent with associated applications such as: RoadEng™, ArcMap™, and Microsoft Office™
- **Knowledgeable** with timber cruising, log quality and costing.
- **Registered** with the Association of BC Forest Professionals (RFT or RPF). *We will also consider applicants with 5+ years of coastal layout experience.*
- **A team-oriented self-starter** who looks for opportunities to improve systems, find efficiencies, and problem solve.
- **Open and positive** with clients and government agencies
- Experience with waste & residue surveys, and/or wildfire planning would also be an asset.
