Company Information

The Forestry Department services 3 facilities, 2 sawmills: White River Forests Products and Hornepayne Lumber, and 1 Co-gen facility: Hornepayne Power. The facilities are operated jointly under common shareholder company WRC Timber and the sawmill facilities have a unique business structure. Both sawmills operate under a partnership structure that includes multiple area First Nations and a local municipality among the partners. Operations supply approximately 1 million cubic meters of fibre to area mills.

About the Area

Hornepayne and White River are small communities located in the 'North Shore' region of Lake Superior in northern Ontario. The area offers great opportunity for outdoor enthusiasts. Communities in the woodshed area also include Wawa, Marathon, Dubreuilville, and Manitouwadge. Regional cities include Thunder Bay and Sault Ste Marie.
