PRIMARY FOCUS

To monitor Log Suppliers Quality and to Monitor Compliance Obligations for White River Forest Products

ACCOUNTABILITIES

Direct (accountable for / authority over):

- Provide Weekly report of all in Field Quality Checks for Log Suppliers of White River Forest Products
- Shall acquire and Maintain a Certified Forest Operations Compliance Certificate and perform weekly Compliance Check on at least 1 Supplier Operation per week. With associated reports submitted to MNR, NFMC & FRMG on a timely basis.
- Develop plans in conjunction with Mill Management & Scaler to FIFO of Log Inventory.
- Works in close Liaison with Sawmill Yard Supt daily on any Log quality concerns.
- Shall acquire and maintain a Certified Scaling Licence from MNR and shall serve as Assistant Scaler or serve as Relief for Vacation.
- Will assist when necessary, in conducting Conversion Factor Sampling to ensure they are completed as per the WRFP Sampling Process.
- Is responsible for the maintenance of all Primary Road Access Signage.
- Promote a safe workplace to achieve the best Health& Safety performance. Promptly reports any near miss, incident, equipment damage.
- Assists when necessary, with Chief Forester and or Woodlands Operations Supt in anyway necessary. Ie. Gravel Pit Permits etc.
- Develop and maintain constructive and positive working relationships with Contractors, MNRF, First Nations and Public to prevent or minimize conflicts jeopardizing our wood supply.
- Acts as liaison with NFMC Field Staff.
- Ensure all activities are carried out in a fashion that respects the company's Forest Environmental Policy as well as all applicable laws and regulations.
- Ensure policies, procedures, and applicable regulations are followed. Respect and adhere to Corporate Principles, Policies and Objectives of the Company
- Works in close liaison with Forestry Staff of White River Forest Products &VP & GM Forestry.
- Takes lead in any Trials regarding Utilization of existing Wood Supply and or development of new Products.
- Conducts Harvest Cutovers Inspections to insure Maximum Utilization and Compliance to all terms of WRFP SFL's
- Assists in the assessment of Water Crossings when required.
- Other Forestry related Technical Duties as required.
